ADDITION WORD PROBLEMS USING TWO-DIGIT NUMBERS WORKSHEET-1

Q1. Sam was thirsty this morning and drank 50 milliliters of juice and 25 milliliters of cola. How much liquid did he drink in all?

Ans: 75

Q2. In the pantry, you had 45 grams of sugar. Today, your mother added 85 grams of sugar. How much sugar is in there now?

Ans: 130

Q3. While waiting in line at the amusement park, Freddie counted the flowers. He counted 35 red flowers and 22 white flowers. How many flowers did he count in all?

Ans: 57

Q4. There are two rolls of tape in class. One is 30 centimeters long, and the other is 90 centimeters long. How much tape do we have altogether?

Ans: 120

Q5. Ken's Classroom has 15 boys and 17 girls. How many students are there in all?

Ans: 32

Q6. Yesterday, 24 adults came to the movie theater. If 17 more children than adults came to the movie theater, how many children came to the movie theater yesterday?

Ans: 41
